

NGT RETURNS TO SEBRING WITH THE STRONGEST LINEUP EVER

Miami, FL. (March 11th 2013) - NGT Motorsport is heading to the 61st Mobil Twelve Hours of Sebring Fueled by "Fresh from Florida" with no less than nine cars this year. Coming off a season ending victory at the 2012 Petit Le Mans & a very strong showing at the 24h of Daytona, NGT Motorsport will be looking for the same success. The team has entered two Porsche 911 GTC class cars in the ALMS opening round and seven 911 Cup cars entered to compete in the IMSA GT3 Cup Series presented by Yokohama.

Returning in the MOMO NGT #30 Porsche GTC car and winner of the last round of 2012 at Petit Le Mans, is Henrique Cisneros. Cisneros will be joined by Porsche Super Cup driver, Sean Edwards. Edwards who had other commitments during last year's Petit round will rejoin Henrique for the year behind the wheel. The third driver entered in the #30 will be Marco Seefried, new to the team but very experienced behind the wheel of a 911. Marco, who is also a Porsche Factory Test-Driver, will bring a lot of veteran leadership to the team in hopes of taking the MOMO NGT #30 car to victory lane.

In the sister #31 NGT GTC car will see some familiar faces to the NGT Motorsport camp. Carlos Gomez, a regular with NGT in the IMSA GT3 Cup series, will be doing double duty in both series this weekend. Gomez has been a contender in the IMSA series for many years. NGT also welcomes back 2012 Petit Le Mans GTC class winners, Mario Farnbacher and Kuba Giermaziak. "Sebring is one of the most difficult circuits. I have not been there but I'm really looking forward to it. I've spent a lot of time talking with other drivers about it and also getting familiar with it on my PlayStation," said Kuba when asked about the upcoming event. Showing a lot of enthusiasm, Kuba also mentioned, "I'm really excited for the weekend!"

With an additional seven cars in IMSA GT3 Cup, NGT Motorsport will be visibly seen this coming weekend. With this many cars and back in the famous "NGT" orange, the team will be making a strong presence. Veteran IMSA GT3 Cup driver Carlos Gomez will be back in the Platinum class in the #26 Axis of Oversteer Porsche. Also returning is the 2010 IMSA GT3 Cup Gold vice-champion, Eduardo Cisneros in the MOMO NGT #29 Porsche GT3 Cup. In the #28 car is Amadeo Quiros who raced with the team at Sebring last year. Joining the veterans will be 2012 IMSA GT3 Cup Gold Champion, Angel Andres Benitez Jr., who has his sights set on the Platinum Championship this year in his NGT #25 Porsche. Craig Duerson, who competed in last year's final round at Road Atlanta, will also be competing for Championship honors in the Platinum Master's class for the season. Duerson showed some good pace at the recent Winter Test at Sebring. NGT Motorsport has been proud with how it develops its drivers. Experienced club racers, Ary Krau and Mark Llano have been preparing for their inaugural starts in the IMSA GT3 Cup series. Llano, an ex-Marine, is racing for a cause to help provide awareness to fellow service men and women. Krau will be the only car from the team competing in the Gold Class.
